Sample food, buy goods, learn about what the region's NGOs. They will show you what is happening in our region and on the earth.



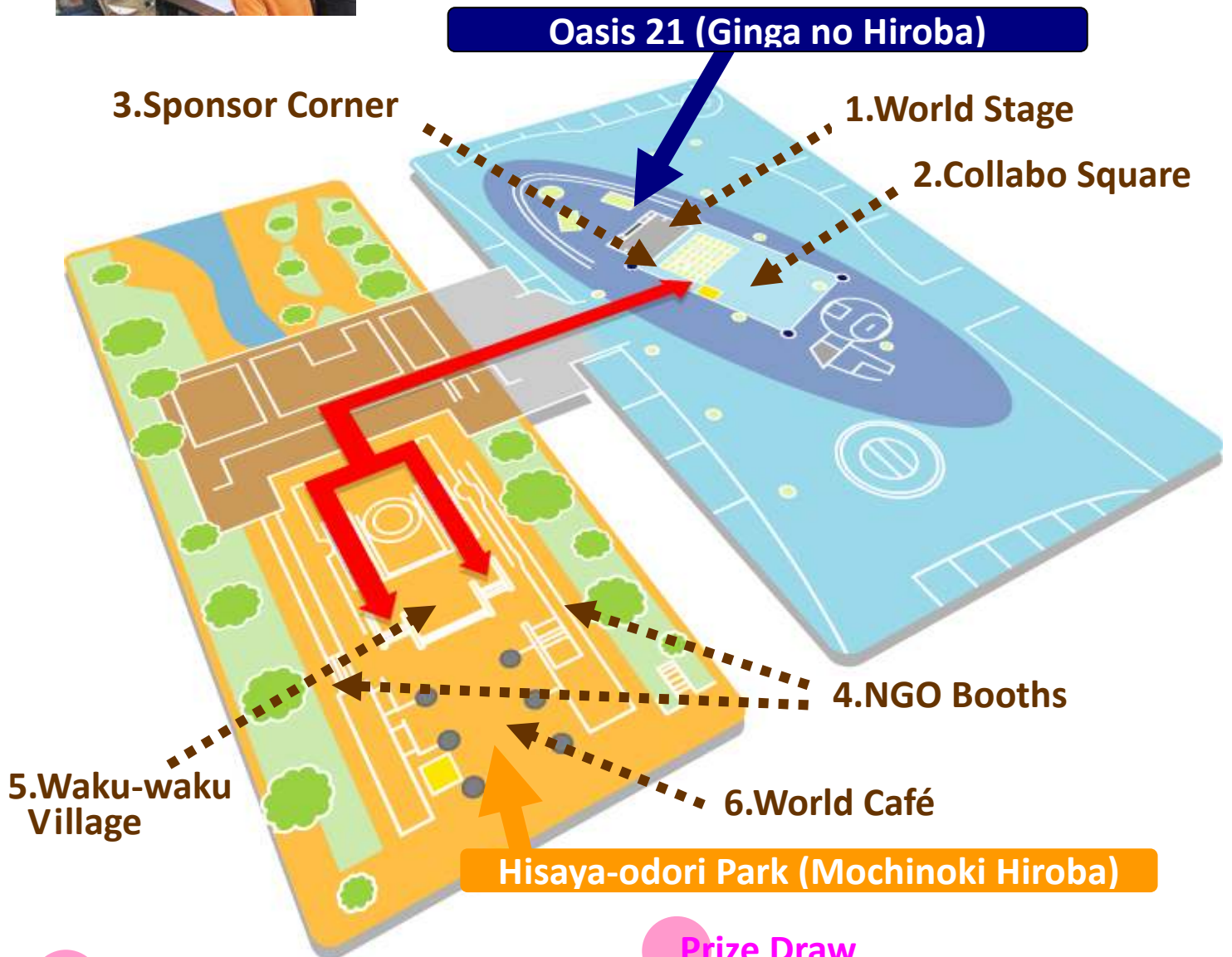
World Café
